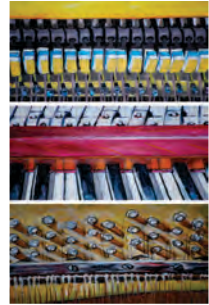

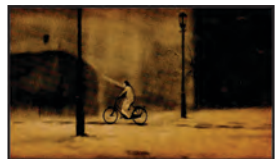

A Department of Education, Training and Employment exhibition supported by the Gallery of Modern Art and toured by Museum and Gallery Services Queensland.



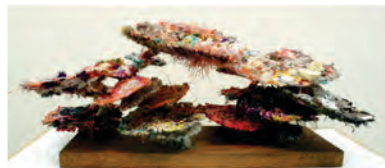

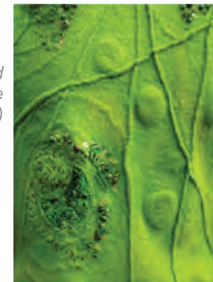

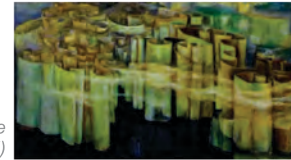
